EMERGENCIES – WHAT TO DO:

Seek Help: Get the attention and assistance of a Hy-Vee INDYCAR Race Weekend or Public Official. Event Security stations overnight staff at the Check-In booth and in roaming vehicles across the property.

Call 911: Inform the operator of your location and site number. Use landmarks for assistance. Hy-Vee INDYCAR Race Weekend provides 24-hour security and emergency medical service coverage with on-call law enforcement officers, paramedics, and emergency medical technicians station on-property.

SERVICES:

Tank Service: Most camp sites at Hy-Vee INDYCAR Race Weekend are not outfitted with sewers, but for your convenience, Onsite Reliable is authorized to service your tanks at a reasonable rate of \$40 per service.

Scheduling: Onsite Reliable will be available in the early evening for service in the campground. Please waive them down or call/text 682.220.3044 to schedule.

ARRIVAL:

Guests may start arriving and parking on RV Hill at 12PM CT on Thursday, July 20.

DEPARTURE:

Motorcoaches and campers are restricted from departing the camping areas during the times of 7-9:30PM on July 22 and July 23. Passenger vehicles may exit immediately. Iowa State Patrol and local Law Enforcement will control the release of all campers and large vehicles following the conclusion of the days final event.

All campers must depart Iowa Speedway by 12pm on Monday, July 24.

RV TRACKSIDE CAMPING REGULATIONS:

CAMPING HOURS:

Gates open at 12:00PM, Thursday, July 20 and close at 12pm on Monday, July 24. A “good neighbor” quiet policy will be in effect beginning at 12:00AM (Midnight Central Time) each evening. Admittance and set-up are restricted when gates are closed.

CHECK-IN:

To enter the RV Hill Camping area, use exit 168 off I-80 to Rusty Wallace Drive and follow Rusty Wallace Drive to Stan Clement Road and the Check-In house will be on your right (follow all traffic signage for trackside camping).

CAMPING RULES:

The RV Hill Camping area is reserved for commercially build motorhomes, 5th-wheels or travel trailers which have an operational bathroom as installed by the original manufacturer. Spaces are 25' wide x 50' deep and include 50-amp electric hook-ups, with Terrace Premier sites on the backstretch including water hook-ups.

RV TRACKSIDE CAMPING AREA REGULATIONS:

- Each site includes 6 individual day passes or weekend passes. Passes permit access to the concourse area and RV Hill. Each individual MUST HAVE an RV Hill ticket to obtain access to RV Hill.
- Each site will receive one (1) large site decal for the camping unit and one (1) smaller decal for the tow vehicle or companion vehicle. The RV Hill check in staff will apply both decals to the vehicles.
- Companion or tow vehicles must be parked in designated areas.
- Weapons of any kind, drones, remote control helicopters, planes or other remote-controlled devices, fireworks, sky lanterns, missile-like objects or projectiles of any kind, explosives and illegal substances are all prohibited. Anyone caught using these items will have them confiscated, and a citation may be issued by city or county law enforcement.
- Signage of any kind is not permitted on the grass banking in front of any RV Hill parking area. Violators will be subject to removal from the premises.
- Charcoal fires are permitted only in standard outdoor cooking grills.
- Pets are not allowed in camping areas. Only service animals will be allowed on property.
- Please place your trash in one of our Midwest Sanitation receptacles, which can be found throughout the Campgrounds. Trash pick up services will begin each morning at 8:00AM CT, weather permitting.
- Tank Servicing: Onsite Reliable is authorized to service your tanks. Servicing will take place each evening.



RV TRACKSIDE CAMPING AREA REGULATIONS Continued:

- First row campers **MUST** lower flags thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the race
- First row campers are not allowed to sit on top of RVs.
- No other camping units (including tents) are allowed on the campsite.
- During an emergency, please call 911 immediately; please identify yourself and your campsite location by Section and Site number. Event Officials will be monitoring emergency channels and will be able to assist emergency personnel in location of the incident inside the campgrounds. Event Officials also have medical and fire team staffed twenty-four (24) hours a day during race weekends. They may be the first to respond to the incident.



SAFETY MESSAGE:

In our efforts towards providing a safe environment for our customers, Hy-Vee INDYCAR Race Weekend and NCOAA are working towards awareness regarding the risks of carbon monoxide (CO) poisoning. CO poisoning can occur when using portable generators, vehicles and other combustible equipment.

WHAT IS MONOXIDE?

- CO is colorless, odorless and tasteless.
- CO is produced from the burning of fuel sources.
- CO poisoning occurs when you breath fumes from those fuel sources.
- CO poisoning is a leading cause of injuries and deaths each year.
- CO is only detectable with an electronic sensor.
- CO can result in loss of consciousness, long term health effects or death.

IMPORTANT FACTS ABOUT CO POISONING

- CO poisoning is often mistaken for a cold, flu, or hangover so be suspicious if these conditions occur suddenly.
- CO poisoning symptoms worsen with the consumption of alcohol or drugs.
- CO exposure is more dangerous for the elderly, smokers, children, pregnant mothers, and those with underlying health issues.

SOURCES OF CO AND HOW TO BE SAFE AROUND THEM

- Portable and RV generators, motorhomes, cars, trucks, campfires, grills, stoves and portable heaters. For your family and neighbor's health and safety, please be mindful to use equipment safely.
- Maintain a minimum distance of 6' (feet) from all CO Sources.
- Ensure that all CO courses are properly vented so CO fumes do not enter yours or your neighbor's RV/campsite.
- Only use CO generating equipment outside, never in a tent, camper, vehicle or inside your home.
- Consider the wind direction while using CO generating sources.
- We recommend that you have a properly functioning CO detector in or near the areas where sleeping may occur.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO IF YOU SUSPECT CO POISONING?:

- Leave the area immediately and seek fresh air
- Call 911, security, or campground office
- Seek medical attention immediately

SEVERE WEATHER PREP & COMMUNICATIONS :

KNOW YOUR PLAN!

STAY ALERT. BE PROACTIVE.

STAY ALERT: Monitor the weather closely and take the necessary precautions to ensure your safety. Iowa Speedway may not provide adequate protection from extremely high winds, lightning, hail, or tornadoes. There is no basement or approved tornado shelter on property.

SECURE LOOSE ITEMS: If you are tailgating or camping, please secure loose items including tents, grills, coolers, flags, and awnings. Seek shelter if conditions worsen.

LIGHTNING: Lightning can strike as far as 10 to 15 miles from the area where it is raining. That's about the distance you can hear thunder. The National Weather Service indicates if you can hear thunder, you are within striking distance, and it recommends seeking shelter immediately.

SHELTER: Though no place is absolutely safe from severe weather, if you are caught outside, the safest location is a large enclosed building. Iowa Speedway has limited enclosed buildings, and if any guests are unable to seek shelter in an enclosed structure. The National Weather Service recommends seeking shelter in an enclosed metal vehicle. The National Weather Service also recommends staying away from tall, isolated objects.
